What to expect after you apply:

Your child's application will be entered into our wait pool and will remain active until you are offered a space, cancel the application, or your child reaches the age of 5. Prospective parents must attend a tour for applications to be considered.

For the Ocean Park Campus, enrollment typically begins in the December prior to the August of enrollment. Throughout the month of January, families are contacted to observe in the classroom and meet with our campus director. Formal admission offers are extended in February with signed tuition contracts to be returned within 5 days of invitation.

For the Marine Park campus, enrollment occurs year round as spaces open up from children matriculating from our infant/toddler program to our preschool program. Priority is given to families who are employees of the City of Santa Monica, followed by Santa Monica residents.
